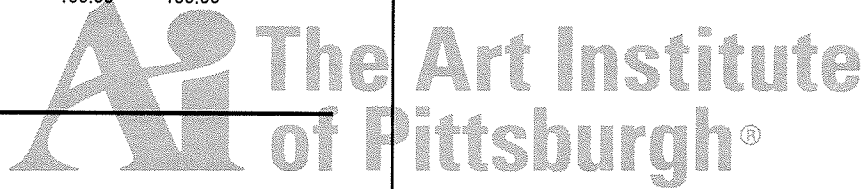

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**ACADEMIC CALENDAR**

The Art Institute of Pittsburgh operates on a quarter system. One quarter consists of eleven weeks, ten week summer, or two five and one-half sessions within a quarter.

**UNIT OF CREDIT**

All course work at The Art Institute of Pittsburgh is measured in quarter credits. One quarter credit is awarded for ten classroom contact hours of lecture, twenty classroom contact hours of laboratory instruction, or thirty contact hours of internship. One classroom contact hour is defined as fifty minutes of instruction in a sixty minute period.
